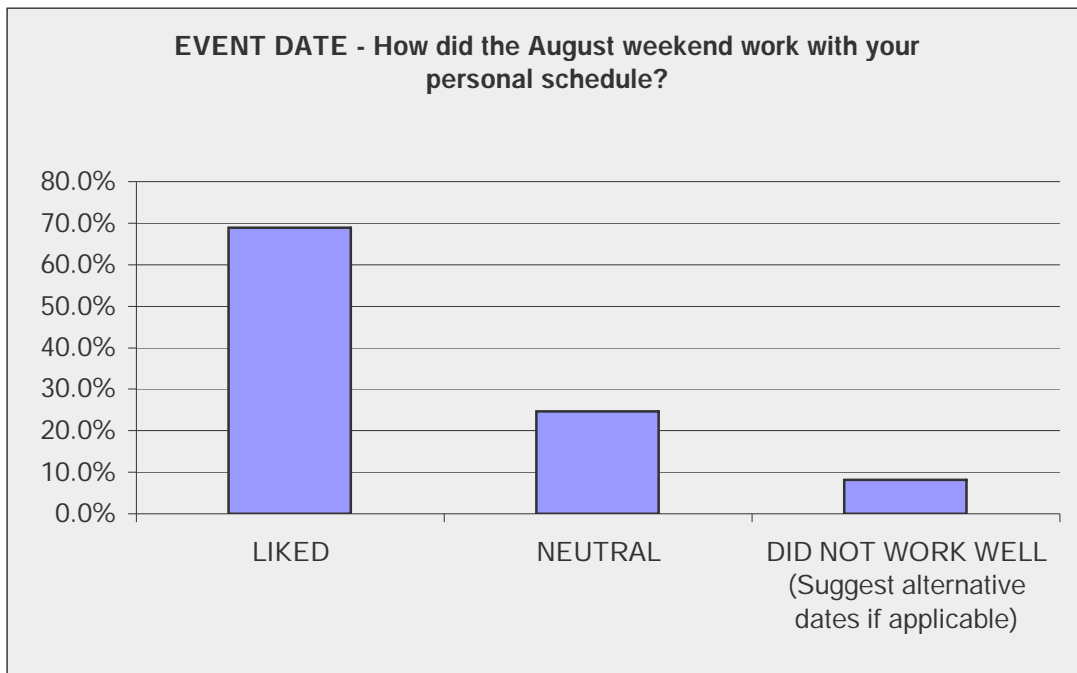

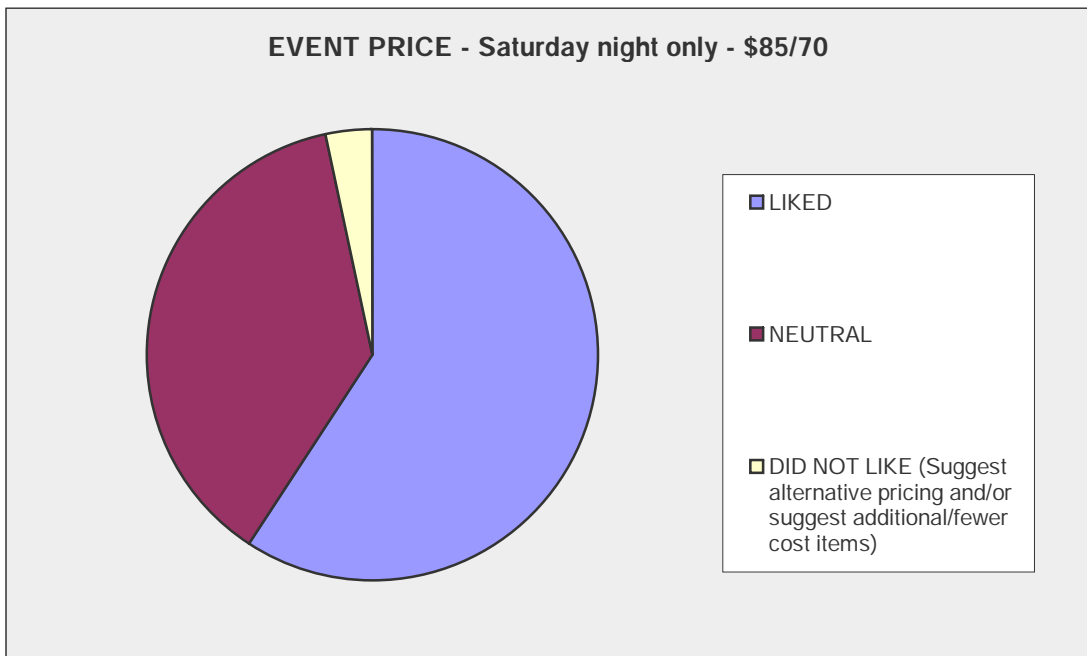
- 1 I thought the date worked quite well

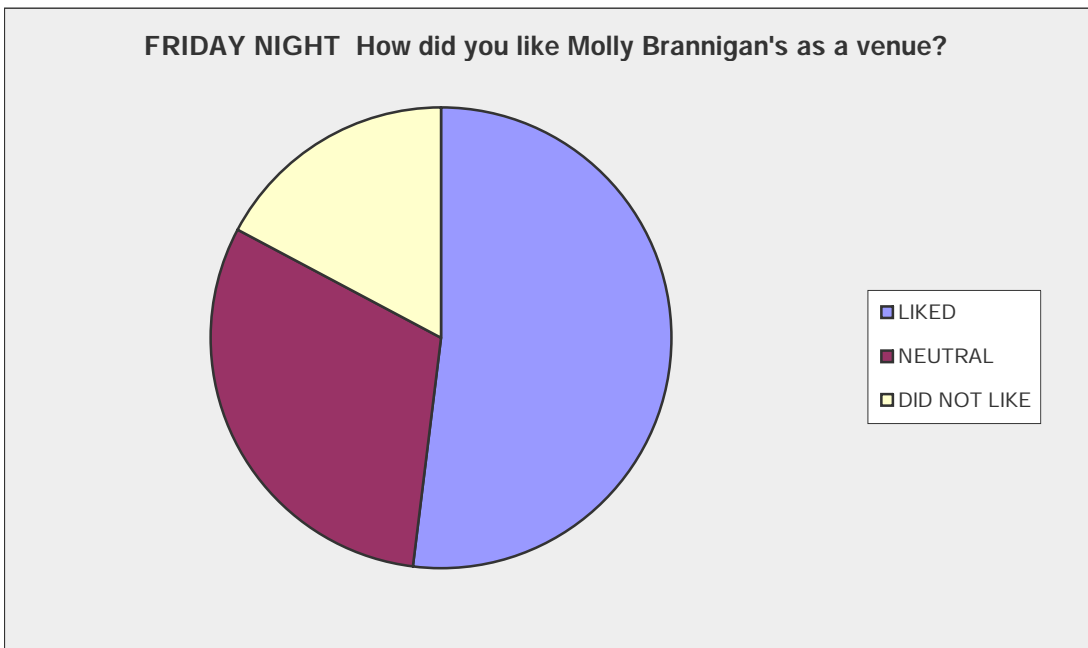

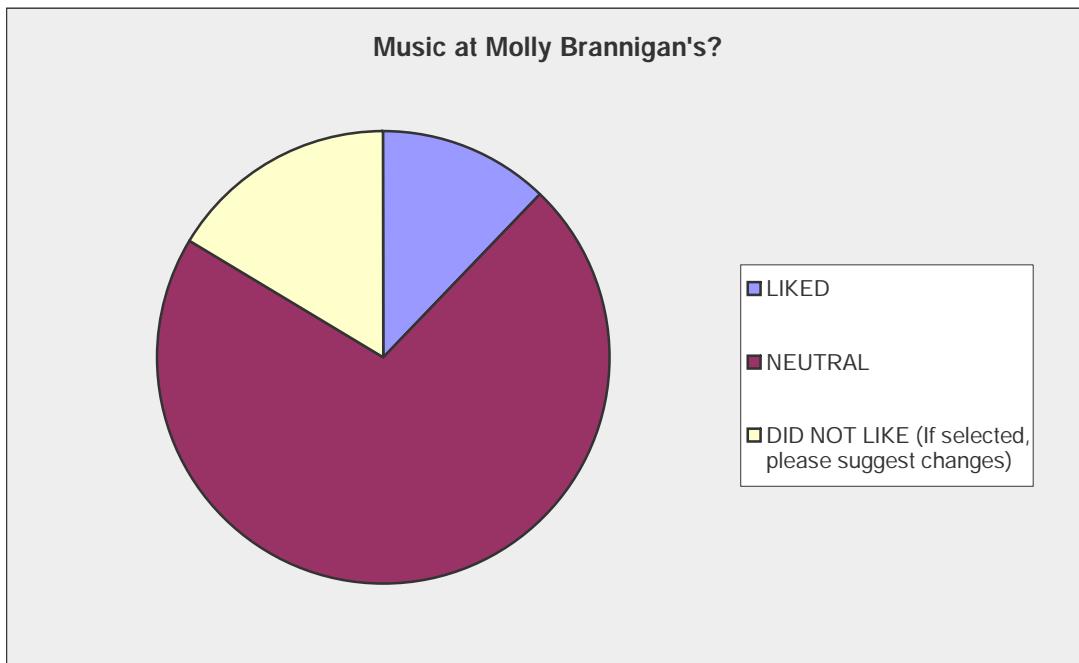
- 1 a little loud - not too private
